



Mahaska County Soccer Club Team Roster Filling Policy

Rosters are the basic lists of designated players and coaches on a team. Roster ages and sizes (including maximums and minimums) are determined by the Iowa Soccer Association and are the standard for play across the state. Since ISA is the standard, MCSC needs to conform in order to be ISA certified, and to play with other communities. If MCSC receives more than the maximum amount of registrations for an age, the board will determine the best option for the players affected and the club. All MCSC rosters will be filled on a first come first served basis. If there are too many (or too little) players in a certain age group, any of the following may happen at the board's discretion.

1. Players may be asked to move up an age group.
2. The last players to register may be placed on a waiting list pending resignations by rostered players. Any player placed on a waiting list will be allowed to practice with a team designated by the board. However, waiting list players will not be allowed to dress for or play in MCSC games (due to the roster limits). **This does not guarantee a place later in the season.** The waiting list will also be on first come first serve basis using the players' registration dates.
3. The last players to register may be issued a refund of their registration fee and allowed to transfer to any other club of the players choosing. MCSC will promptly issue any transfer documents necessary for players to go to another club.

MCSC will do their utmost to make the **PLAYERS** the priority in these situations, and want as many participants as possible. Our club doesn't grow without the kids and their interest! Prompt and early registration is the biggest key to helping the club in these determinations.
